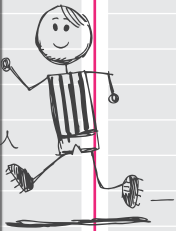


He took a year off to travel to Canada and the USA working in retail in Toronto and travelling around the USA before his funds ran out.
