

Shocking Role-play

Read the information on the fact sheet '**Shocking!**'

In groups, create a drama scene about an injury involving electricity. The scene should get across important messages about the safe use of electricity.

1. Start by writing down the key messages that you want to get across (Remember: there's the risk of electric shock but electricity is also a fire hazard).
2. Decide who the characters will be.
3. Decide how the injury is going to occur.
4. Decide which character receives the injury and who was responsible for the hazard.

This could be:

- a. the injured person (e.g. someone who uses a hair dryer with wet hands)
 - b. someone else in the house (e.g. someone who leaves a CD player in the bathroom, where it can get wet).
5. Decide how the scene will conclude.

Improvise your scene and then discuss, as a group, what worked well and what could be improved next time.

Challenge

Perform your scene for the class and watch other groups' scenes. Which were most effective and entertaining? Why?
