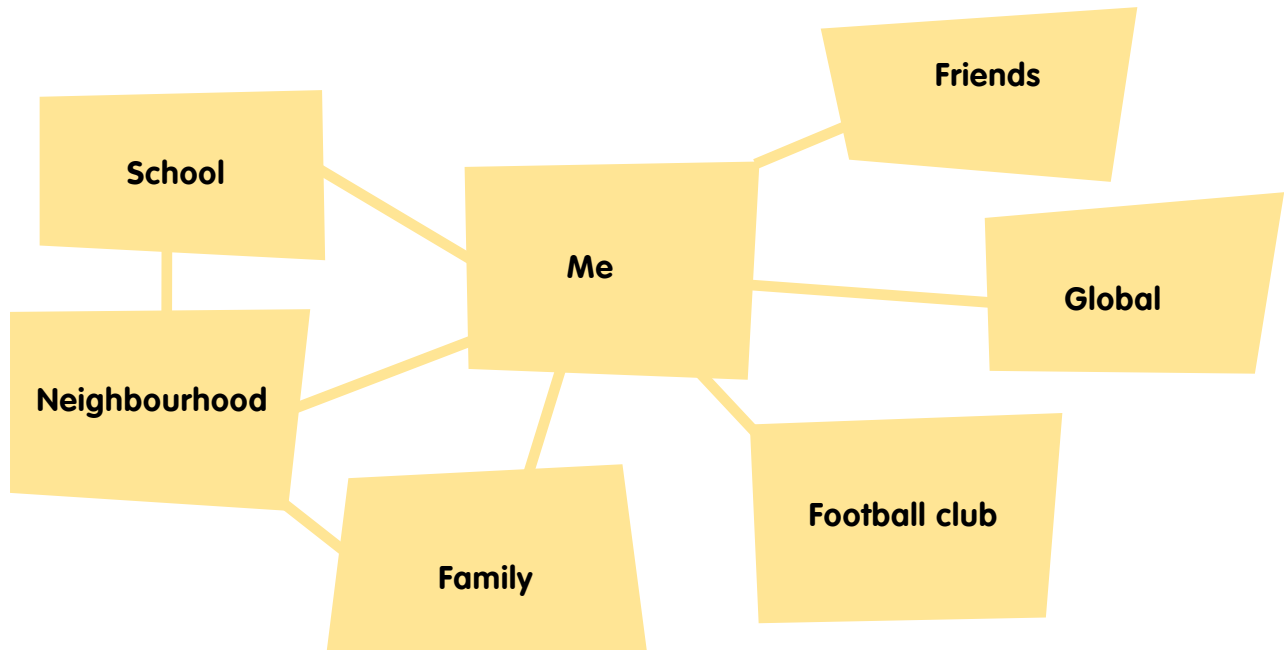




COMMUNITIES: Community Spaces

The diagram below is an example of how one person can belong to lots of different communities. Create a similar diagram showing the different communities you belong to.



Now with three of your friends, research what communities they belong to and create an interconnected web of the four of you. Where do you overlap? Where are you separate?

Activity

Select a public building or space in your local community (e.g. town hall, library, park) and investigate the types of activities that go on there. Consider:

- who uses it?
- how it is funded?
- how it is run?
- how does the community feel about it?

Imagine that the local council announced plans to demolish it to build a block of flats. Write a letter to the council expressing your opinion, either supporting or disagreeing with the plans and why.
