

## Curriculum Links - Sustainable Schools for KS2

The Government aims for all schools to be sustainable by 2020 and asks them to ‘prepare young people for a lifetime of sustainable living’ (Department for Children, Schools and Families, now the Department for Education) through their practice and teaching. The National Framework for Sustainable Schools (published in 2006) is broken into eight sustainability themes or ‘doorways’ through which schools can establish or develop their sustainability practices.

The table below shows how our Sustainable Houses programme relates to the Sustainable Schools doorways by indicating which fact or work sheets relate to each.
